deepened	his guitar knowledge and studied at the school "Escola do Guitarrista Gaúcho",
	where he worked later on as a teacher himself.
1980	he became a guitarist and composer of "Raiz de Pedra", one of the most popular
	brasil. fusionbands in Brazil, which published in 3 Jahren four Instrumental-CDs:
	"Trajetória", "Raiz de Pedra ao vivo", "Pictures", "Diário de Bordo".
	The last CD was published by the german label Enja Records.
	On the Album "Diario de Bordo" arranged and played the worldfamous brazilian
	pianist Egberto Gismonti 4 titels, 2 of them was composed by Pedro Taglianis. Since
1993	Pedro Tagliani is living in Europe and is active with a lot of projects as guitarist and
	arranger. He has played in a huge number of CDs and worked together with
	international well know musicians like Dave Samuels, Wolfgang Lackerschmidt.
1998	he began his solocareer with the publishing of his CD "Arvoredo", which was
	recorded in Vienna in cooperation of the famous saxplayer Thomas Kugi.
	During this new segment of his career Pedro Tagliani played beside others on the
	Guitarfestival of Bad Aibling "Saitensprünge", in front of Ralph Towner und Oregon
	& Aquarelas do Brasil & Brazil Connection.
